## **Frequently Asked Questions**

*How do I become a member of the parish?* 

Membership in the Orthodox Church begins at baptism (Chrismation for some) and continues throughout our life. We are united with Christ through the sacraments, or mysteries, of the Church and through our faithful offering of our entire selves to Jesus Christ. An important part of that membership is a commitment to support the church financially with tithes and offerings, and to serve in a ministry side by side with your brothers and sisters. In doing this, we are true members of the Body of Christ involved in living according to His word and within the Church. ("The whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love." Eph 4:16)

Why must I commit to give a specific amount? Please keep in mind that your stewardship of money is kept in the strictest of confidence. However, we do compile the amounts anticipated to better plan our budget.
